

CHILDREN'S CURRICULUM :

STUDENT POLITICIANS:

How politicians' classes are formed and what are the main schools for them?









Politics classes present in high school syllabus BUT hours often replaced by other subjects. MAIN REASON : NO EXAM

France: politics and social education classes organized as monologues : professors EXPLAIN, students LISTEN



Possible Solution

Germany: Politics classes not mandatory. Students have to **pass EXAM** to validate.

Specialized professors give classes. Topics : German, European and International relations and politics in 21st century. Course structure: **speech analysis, discussions and presentations.**



Adaptation to France

Introduction of a **FINAL EXAM** and change in teaching method : **more DEBATES**, **more STAGES**, **more CONFERENCES**



Situation in France

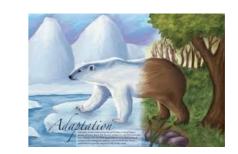
French politicians have **SIMILAR BACKGROUNDS**

Adaptation to France

Impossible to FORCE people with different backgrounds to join politics, impossible to LIMIT the number of politicians coming from a certain school. SOLUTION: OPENFORUM WEB PLAT-FORM to easily communicate ideas. Put different backgrounds at the service of community. CAREERS NOT LOST

Situation in France



France: citizens >18 VOTE.

Student Parallel Election Program to BUILD skills and habits of citizenship among young Canadians. Students' knowledge and interest in politics INCREASED. Student vote in middle school and high school. Part of politics classes

CONCLUSIONS

High abstention rate:

- Need to remotivate citizens, begin early : from school (more courses)
- Form citizens aware of their rights and duties (with a critical mind)
- Involve people in public decisions



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
