PEDAGOGICAL APPROACH



TEACHING AND EXPERTISE

The programme runs over 12 days spread across 6 months and is structured into four learning modules. The two-day, face-to-face sessions include lectures, expert talks, case studies, industrial site visits, and work on a collaborative project. Sessions are delivered by ISAE-SUPAERO faculty, as well as academic, institutional and industry experts.

PROJECT-BASED APPROACH

Participants work in teams on a strategic and operational challenge addressing the future of the space sector, selected from a range of major issues facing the industry. They develop a well-grounded analysis, drawing on insights from the experts and professionals they meet throughout the certificate.

- **A final presentation to a jury**

MICROLEARNING

Before each on-site training session, participants will engage in microlearning modules. Key topics will then be debated during face-to-face sessions.
